Such a violation could result in my being fined up to \$1,000 or being confined in the county jail for up to six months, or both a fine and imprisonment. If the case for which I am being released is a felony, I may be charged with an additional felony violation pursuant to Penal Code 1320(b). Such a violation could result in my being fined up to \$5,000 or my imprisonment in state prison or county jail for up to one year, or both fine and imprisonment.
